


Riding a Mobike on the street, you might hear some people speaking Chinese aloud. Turning to the right, you see a Sichuan-style restaurant. After walking into a store, you see that Huawei smartphones are

on sale. But you're not in China - you're in Manchester in Britain. In fact, you might see similar things in many other cities. Chinese products have almost reached all parts of the world.

Chinese food has been enjoyed in Western countries for a long time. To meet local people's tastes, Chinese restaurants have made some changes to the dishes. "One example is the meat," said Yin Hang, who is studying at the University of Wollongong in Australia. "We like to eat meat with the bone in, but people here don't. So Chinese restaurants provide big pieces of meat without bones, even for fish."

Some Chinese brands are also becoming more popular. In many cities in Europe, stores sell TCL televisions, Haier fridges and Lenovo computers, reported Reuters.

In the past, most western people thought Chinese products were cheap and unreliable. But things have changed greatly. "Made in China" has become cool and more people believe in Chinese brands. For example, Huawei smartphones sold better than Apple for the first time in June and July, behind only Samsung. "They are beautiful and offer some features (特点) that American phones don't have," CNN once said.

Cultural Differences between China and the US

Living in a culture that is different from your own can be both an exciting and challenging experience. You have to learn different cultural practices and try to get used to them. Let's share the top four cultural differences between China and the US to help understand each other better.

Privacy(隐私)

Chinese people do not have the same understanding of privacy as Americans do. They think it common to talk about topics such as ages, pay or marriage, which Americans think is unpleasant.

Family & Friends

In China, people traditionally treat elders and the young kindly. In America, the goal of the family is to encourage independence of the children. Unlike the Chinese, older Americans seldom live with their children.

As for friendship, Chinese people have different meanings about it. Just hanging out together from time to time is not friendship. Friendship means lifelong friends who can offer help to each other whenever their friends need. Americans always call people friends in different social situations, so the exact meaning of friends is general and different. There are working friends, playing friends, school friends and drinking friends.

Money & Education

As is well known, the Chinese like to save. They are always conservative(保守的) when they are planning to spend money. It is different in the USA, where far fewer families are saving money for unexpected situations and education than the Chinese families.

Chinese people pay more attention to education and jobs than Americans, who think more about good character and strong belief.

Collectivism(集体主义) vs. Individualism(个人主义)

China values the collectivism and the US values the individualism. If you achieve something in the US, it's because you are great. While in China, if you achieve something, it's because the team, or family, or company is great. Everything you do connects with the greater whole, while in America the person himself or herself is celebrated.
