**书面表达评分标准:**

第一档: (13~15 分)

第四档: (0~4 分)

与题目有关内容不多, 只是简单拼凑提示词语, 所写内容难以理解。

OK. Now, I'll tell you something about the library. I'm sure you'll enjoy working here. The library's closed today because we're moving things around and when the new term starts tomorrow we'll be really busy.
