In Chinese culture, people believe some numbers are lucky or unlucky. This is to see what Chinese character the number sounds like. For example, the Chinese word for the number 8 sounds like the word for "making a fortune". So, people think it is a very lucky number. Some people spend a lot of money to have 8s in their phone numbers. The opening time of the Beijing Olympics began at 8:08 p.m. on August 8, 2008.

Wiki is the Hawaiian(夏威夷语) word for "quick". Today, it is a very popular word among Internet users. What does it mean? Wiki is a website where everyone can create and change its pages. The most famous wiki is Wikipedia, an online encyclopedia that offers millions of articles. But there are lots of other wikis such as Wikihow, Wikinews and Wikidictionary. They all have one thing in common. They are created and managed by a wiki

community.

A wiki community is made up of the millions of people who visit a wiki site. Many of the visitors are readers looking for information. Some visitors are _____ who create articles for the site. Other visitors act as editors (编辑) who read the articles and check them for mistakes. Wiki are simple to create and use, and they are becoming more and more popular.

But is wiki information reliable? If anyone can add, delete or change information, can the information be trusted? This depends on the wiki community. The community usually tries to make sure that the information on a topic is correct. If someone in the community sees an article with incorrect information, that person can edit or change it.


