#### **The Mastery Phase**





On the northern bank of the lake are the Naren Wetlands, which are home to tens of thousands of birds, and many of them are in danger.

Forty-two-year-old Jia Wu Cai Rang is a Tibetan. His family is living in the Naren Wetlands. People there need a peaceful place to live. But unluckily, from the 1990s, some poachers (偷猎者) came, breaking he peace of the lake, where they began to make a living by killing, catching and selling birds.



In 1997, Qinghai Lake became a state-level natural reserve. This gave the resources of the Naren Wetlands full protection. Cai Rang says he is not only protecting the wetland and its birds, but also taking care of hurt birds as they can return to Mother Nature at an early date.

Cai Rang sees the birds as his family members. Whenever he was time, he goes to the reserve to visit his friends. He sometimes feeds the birds in the fields to help them because they don't have enough food.

During the past 26 years, Cai Rang has treated and cured (治愈) more than 10 water-fowls. In the Qinghai Lake area, birds species (物种) have grown from 164 in the 1990s to 191 now. In the best seasons, tens of thousands of birds make the place a heaven for birds.



Many people traveled to Las Vegas, Nevada at the beginning of 2017 for the 50th Consumer Electronics Show (消费电子展), or CES. The show is said to have the largest collection of new electronic device (设备) in the world.



The 2017 show had many examples of "smart home" devices. "Smart home" technology is to make life easier for people by letting computers control (控制) many things inside our homes.

One such device actually begins working outside the home, when someone arrives and rings the doorbell. Jeremy Warren from smart home service company Vivint said, "When someone comes to your front door and rings the doorbell, the light can turn on immediately. I get a message when I'm halfway around the world that someone came, and I can start talking to the person who's at my front door, and I can say, 'here let me let you in.' I can open the door for him/her very easily."

Another use of smart home technology is being able to watch what is taking place in your home whether you are just around the corner or half way around the world.

One electronics maker Petcube made a device that lets you remotely (遥远地) watch and talk to your pet when you are away. It can even feed the pet.

For heating or cooling, there is a smart thermostat (调温器). This device can also send you a message if a big storm causes flooding (漏水). "We're trying to catch it before it becomes a real big problem." said Mike Sale of iDevices.

Another product, from iDevices, can turn your smartphone into a remote control for an electric fireplace.

While most of the devices can be controlled from anywhere, they also work in the same way when you are at home. Some devices, like Amazon's Echo and Google Home, even let you use your voice to tell them what to do.

A worry for many homeowners is the possibility that someone else might find a way to attack (攻击) these smart home devices. An official from Vivint said his company is sure that only owners of the home can use the information on the devices.

Warren Katz from iDevices said the engineers in his company work hard to stop attacking. "So we spend an awful lot of time making sure that our products are both safe and safe from attack."

Many of these devices at the Consumer Electronics Show were not new things. But now they communicate better and can learn repeat behavior (重复行为), Many of them can be bought for less than \$ 100.
