Living in a culture that is different from your own can be both an exciting and challenging experience. Let's have a look at the information below.

Privacy

Chinese people do not have the same idea of privacy as Americans do. They talk about topics such as ages, income or marriage, which Americans think is annoying and makes them uncomfortable.

Family

In China, elders are traditionally treated with a lot of respect while the young are cherished (关爱). In America, the goal of the family is to encourage independence, particularly that of the children. Unlike the Chinese, older Americans seldom live with their children.

Friends

Chinese people think that hanging out together from time to time is not friendship. Friendship means lifelong friends who should give each other whatever help might seem required. Americans always call people they meet friends, so the definition of friends is general and different. There are work friends, playing friends, school friends and drinking friends.

Money

As is well known, the Chinese like to save. They always plan how to spend money. It is different in the USA, where far fewer families are saving money for emergencies and education.

Education

Chinese people value education and career more than Americans, while Americans pay more attention to good character and faith.

Individualism



Basically China values the community and the US values the individual. If you achieve something in the USA, it's because you are great. While in China, if you achieve something it's because the team, or family, or company is great. Everything you do depends on the greater whole, while in America individual value is celebrated.

One evening about 20 years ago, I watched a documentary about how, in 1947, a “flying saucer” had crashed in Roswell. Several people who had seen the crash were interviewed, including a nurse who said she had examined an alien who had been injured in the crash. At first, the people of Roswell were told that a flying saucer had crashed. Shortly afterwards they were told that it was not a flying saucer but a weather balloon. I decided that the only way I could learn the truth about flying saucers was to investigate (调查) them myself.

I have done a lot of research and although I still haven't discovered the truth about Roswell, I have discovered the truth about hundreds of other UFOs. A lot of UFOs are actually army planes or weather balloons, while others turn out to be natural phenomena (现象) like planets or comets (彗星). By far the largest number of UFOs turn out to be so-called “fireball” meteors—slow-moving meteors that can take up to a minute to travel across the night sky.

When I'm investigating a UFO report, I arrange to meet the person at the place where they have seen the flying saucer. I like to interview a witness at the scene and then take photographs of the area. Then I speak to my contacts at local military (军事的) bases and weather station, and then check the witness' details against my information.

In about 95% of the cases I've dealt with, the “flying saucers” turn out to be weather balloons, planes or natural phenomena. That still leaves 5% of that, no matter what, just cannot be explained.

Painting and writing on walls is nothing new. In prehistoric (史前的) times, people in Africa and Europe painted pictures of animals and people in caves. Graffiti has been found at ancient sites in Greece, Italy, Syria and Iraq. In the Roman town of Pompeii in Italy, archaeologists found a lot of graffiti written in Latin, including political and romantic messages, and even some magic spells!

In the 1970s, young people in New York used pens to write their names, or "tags", on walls around the city. One of the first "taggers" was Demetrius, a teenager from a Greek family. He wrote his tag on walls in his neighbourhood and in subway stations on the way to school. Other teenagers saw Demetrius's tag and started writing their own tags on walls, buses and subway trains all over New York. Then, some teenagers stopped using pens and started using paints. Their tags were bigger and more colourful and appeared on trains, buses and walls around the world. In the 1990s and 2000s, a lot of graffiti artists started to make pictures too.

In many countries, it is a crime to paint on walls and street artists can have problems with the police. In other countries, street art is *permitted* in certain places. Nowadays, street art is more popular with the public. In some cities, there are street art festivals. In Bristol in the UK, there is a street art festival in August every year. Artists paint all the buildings in a street. Lots of people come to watch the artists and take photos. Street art can be seen in galleries (美术馆) too. There have been exhibitions of street art in galleries in Paris, London and Los Angeles.

Most street artists are young people who paint in their neighbourhood or home city. Many of them use the Internet to communicate and share photos of their pictures with other street artists around the world. Although we don't know what will happen to street art in the future, we can be sure that it is here to stay!

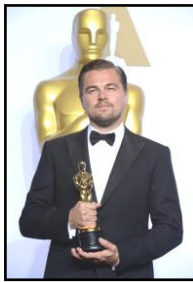

Leonardo DiCaprio finally won an Oscar on February 28, taking home the best actor statuette for his role in “*The Revenant*”. DiCaprio had four nominations before for an acting Oscar over a career spanning 25 years. And it was the first Oscar win for Leonardo.

DiCaprio, who was born in Hollywood California (November 11, 1974), is an American actor and film producer. DiCaprio was the only child of his family. He was named Leonardo because his pregnant (怀孕的) mother was looking at a Leonardo da Vinci painting in a museum when he first kicked.

In the early 1990s, DiCaprio began his career by appearing in TV commercials (商业广告). In 1993, he began his film career by starring as Josh in *Critters 3*. With “*The Different Sky*” amazing performance, DiCaprio won the Oscar nomination for Best Supporting Actor for the first time in 1994. In 1997, DiCaprio starred in “*Titanic*” as twenty-year-old Jack, a poor man who wins two tickets for the third-class on Titanic. This film changed him into a movie superstar, resulting in getting many fans among teenage girls and young women. After that, with amazing performance in “*The Aviator* (2004)”, “*Blood Diamond* (2006)”, “*The Wolf of Wall Street* (2013)”, DiCaprio earned three Oscar nominations for Best Actor, but unfortunately he failed to win against other actors. In total, DiCaprio has gained five nominations in his 22 years' journey in Oscar chase.

This year, for his role of a wilderness hunter, DiCaprio finally got his way. “*The Revenant*” bagged three Oscars at the 88th Academy Awards. DiCaprio's performance gained worldwide praise that earned him many awards, including his first win at the Academy Awards in the Best Actor award, his third win at Golden Globes in the Best Actor Drama award.

“No matter what you do, two things matter. Try to lead an interesting life and no matter what your life is like, try to find a way to wake up every morning and just be happy you can put your pants on.” Leonardo told Britain's GQ magazine.
