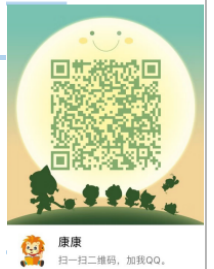

4. Don't say "I'm full" . Just put the fork and knife across the plate. This means you have finished eating.

5. Cut large pieces of meat, potatoes and vegetables into pieces. Eat the pieces one at a time.

6. Never take a huge mouthful of anything. And it is not polite to talk when your mouth is full of food.

7. It's never good to reach across the table for anything. If the thing you want is not at hand, just ask the nearest person for help.

Have you ever dreamed about sending a letter to yourself or your friends in the future? While express mail (快递) is a fast way to send your letters, there is another type of mail appearing in China as a new business—future mail.

"The letter should be sent on the next Mother's Day and not a day earlier!" Lin Xiaofan, a college student in Shanghai, tells one of the companies offering the service.

Lin Xiaofan wrote the letter to her mother nearly a year earlier to express her love to her mother for the next Mother's Day.

"Offering this service makes people slow down and lets them understand the meaning of 'time' in another way, " said Zheng Zhimin, manager at a "future mail" company. Zheng thinks "future mail" letters remind us of care, friendship and love.

While "future mail" is becoming more and more popular, some people are wondering what will happen if the postal address changes or if the company goes bankrupt (倒闭的) before the letters arrive.

Zheng said customers are glad to sign a contract (签订合同) to make sure that they can be compensated if their letters are lost or damaged.

Most of the customers are college students and young white-collar (白领) workers. Psychologists (心理学家) said that young Chinese might have a new way to express their feelings through this service. Most people put their hopes and wishes in the letter so that they can experience the connection (联系) between the past and the present when they receive the letter.

Many people travel to different places in the world by air. Usually it takes a long time, perhaps half a day, for passengers to stay in the plane. So airlines (航空公司) offer passengers food. But it is common that they feel bad about food taste. Do you agree?

To solve this problem, airlines try hard to improve their food. They would like to do because they don't want to lose customers.

However, according to scientific research, part of the reason why plane food tastes bad is that at high altitude (海拔) we can not taste things as well as we do on the ground. Also scientists have found that our noses become very dry even before a plane takes off. As the plane moves up, the change in air pressure (气压) reduces one third of the sensibility (感觉) of our taste buds (味蕾) . So our taste buds become senseless. However, our noses don't know it.

All of these help explain why food on the plane tastes so bad. They also help explain why airlines choose to offer passengers salty and spicy food. Without doing so, the food would be tasteless. Now there are many researches on this. According to one of them, some volunteers are asked to lie with their feet higher than their heads for weeks. And scientists write down their feelings about food taste.

Though scientists try their best, it is not as easy as they thought. Because they can't deal with the special environment successfully, such as the change in air pressure. Making plane food good is still hard for them.
