We know that many animals do not stay in one place. Birds, fish and other animals move from one place to another at a certain time. They move for different reasons most of them move to find food more easily, but others move to get away from places that are too crowded. When cold weather comes, many birds move to warmer places to find food. Some fishes give birth in warm water and move to cold water to feed. The most famous migration (迁移) is probably the migration of the fish, which is called "salmon" . This fish is born in fresh water but it travels many miles to salt water. There it spends its life. When it is old, it returns to its birthplace in fresh water. Then it gives birth and dies there. In northern Europe, there is a kind of mice. They leave their mountain homes when they become too crowded. They move down to the low land. Sometimes they move all the way to the seaside, and many of them are killed when they fall into the sea.

Recently, scientists have studied the migration of a kind of lobsters (龙虾) . Every year, when the season of bad weather arrives, the lobsters get into a long line and start to walk across the floor of the ocean. Nobody knows why they do this, and nobody knows where they go. So, sometimes we know why humans and animals move from one place to another, but at other times we don't. Maybe living things just like to travel.

In Ghana, farmers think of bamboo as a useless plant. But Kwabena Danso, a businessman, thinks bamboo is very useful. He runs a company called Boomers International which makes bike frames (框架) out of bamboo. The bike parts are sent from Mr. Danso's village to other countries, including Germany, the Netherlands and Australia.

The company makes about 50 bicycles frames each month. Young men from nearly village come to work at Boomers International. Mr. Razak, one of the company's workers, says that without this job, he would still be living at home with his parents. The job helps him a lot.

Mr. Danso has sold only a few of his bamboo bicycle frames within Ghana. Walter Kudzodzi is one of his customers (顾客) . He bought a bicycle earlier this year. Mr Kudzodzi says his bike gets a lot of attention when he rides around his neighbourhood.

"For example, on Saturdays, I rode about five kilometers around my neighborhood and everywhere I went, people would come close to me and say, 'Wow, we heard about this, but this is the first time we've seen it. Does it work?' I say, 'Yeah, try it.'"

How should a mother talk to her children at a young age? It influences the children's social skills later in childhood, a study from the UK says.

The study found that if children's mothers often talked to them about people's feelings, they developed social understanding better. However, this effect becomes weaker from ages 10 to 12, perhaps because as children get older, they spend less time at home, and their friends and teachers influence them more.

Researchers encourage parents to talk to children when they are watching TV or movies together. "What may the characters be feeling? " they can ask the question like that. And, if someone is shouting in the supermarket, this is another chance to talk to a child about other people's feelings. It's important for parents to give children vocabulary of feelings. Children don't always realize what their feelings are and need to have words to describe them. A researcher said, "Let's say a young takes a toy away from another young child. It's helpful for parents to say something like 'That makes him sad when you take it rather than saying 'Stop it'."

Social understanding is important, but it isn't everything. Children who showed good social skills in the study also behaved negatively. They ran model cars over their mothers' in the test. That's because the children felt more comfortable when they did it. So helping children have social understanding is just the first step for young mothers, a researcher says.
