I am not a fan of flying. I prefer to take a trip by train. Here are some reasons.

Compared to airplanes, trains have more space. The seats are wider often more comfortable. There's a lot more leg room. Trains have many seats that face each other with a table between every two of them. This is great for me, as I could easily spread out my books and do some writing. I could even put my laptop on it.

Train travel is flexible. Most trains don't require us to book a ticket ahead of time, which means we can just show up, buy a ticket and get on board. There are also a lot of choices when it comes to leaving times. Usually we can get to somewhere by taking trains that leave at different time.

We don't have to arrive hours before the train leaves. Forget waiting in long lines. At the train station, we just walk in and board our train. We don't have to walk through any body scanners (扫描器), and our luggage doesn't need to be x-rayed or searched. This means there's no need to arrive hours before the train leaves. In fact, on our first train trip, we jumped on board just as the doors were closing behind us!

When we're on a train, the only thing we need to do is sitting back and enjoying the scenery. Unlike cars, there's no traffic jam to deal with and we don't have to worry about taking a wrong turn and getting lost. About ten men in every hundred suffer from color blindness in some way. Women are luckier; only about one in two hundred is affected in this matter. Perhaps, after all, it is safer to be driven by a woman!

There are different forms of color blindness. In some cases a man may not be able to see deep red. He may think that red, orange and yellow are all shadows of green. Sometimes a person cannot tell the difference between blue and green. In rare cases an unlucky man may see everything in shades of green — a strange world indeed.

Color blindness in human beings is a strange thing to explain. In a single eye there are millions of very small things called "cones" . These help us to see in a bright light and to tell difference between colors. There are also millions of "rods" , but these are used for seeing when it is near dark. They show us shape but no color.

Some insects have favorite colors. Mosquitoes prefer blue to yellow. A red light will not attract insects, but a blue lamp will. In a similar way human beings also have favorite colors. Yet we are lucky. With the aid of the cones in our eyes we can see many beautiful colors by day, and with the aid of rods we can see shapes at night. One day we may even learn more about the invisible colors around us.

Almost all theme park accidents can be prevented. Here, based on theme park safety, are some tips to help you and your family stay safe on your next visit.

Stay Cool, and Don't Get Burned

Heat causes more pain and injury at theme parks than all the world's roller coasters (过山车) combined. Water is your best friend in helping prevent heat-related illnesses in theme parks. Choose water rather than juice and soft drinks whenever you get thirsty. Put on a waterproof sunscreen before you enter the park. A hat or sunglasses can help, too.

On any theme park ride, keep your rear (后部) on the seat, your hands on the grab bar (扶手) and your feet and knees inside the car. If there is no grab bar, keep your hands on your lap (膝部) . If you are riding a "floorless" coaster, relax your legs. Don't kick them out to the side or front. Do not get on or off a ride until you've been given the okay by an attendant to do so.

Help the Kids

If you are visiting with a child, tell them how they should behave. Meanwhile, parents also know the following rules, too.

★Tell them to stay seated, to hold the grab bar or put their hands in the laps.



★And never put a crying child on a ride. If your child starts to cry, let others pass you in line until your child is calmed. Or, gently exit the queue and find something more relaxing to do.

★Let them take plenty of breaks.

"Kids get tired, " said TPI reader Matt Johnson, a father of four. "Tired kids make parents even more tired. And tired kids and parents get hurt — physically and emotionally." He advises that parents plan a mid-day break, perhaps a swim back at the hotel, to avoid mid-day heat and crowds. "You will see many families having a miserable time while you are refreshed and having a great evening."
