Technology has become an important part of our lives. It has changed our lives in many ways. In many ways, it makes life more convenient for us: we can send messages quickly through the Internet, cook meals in a few minutes in a microwave, and book train tickets online instead of walking to the station. However, in our increasingly technology driven world, have we become addicted to (上瘾的) technology?

Not too long ago, many children enjoyed reading a good book in their spare time. Nowadays, young people are more likely to be seen playing video games or watching television. Some people even say they can't go without watching their favourite TV programme! Similarly, sending letters has become a thing of the past. It has been replaced by email, instant messaging and social media. I think this is a huge shame. For me, there's nothing better than receiving a letter in the post. Fifteen years ago, I took a summer vacation in Lecce in southern Italy. After climbing up a hill for a panoramic(全景的) view of the blue sea, white buildings and green olive trees, I paused to catch my breath and then decided to take the best photo of this panorama.

Unfortunately, just as I took out my camera, a woman appeared from behind, and stood right in front of my view. Like me, this woman was here to stop, take a break and appreciate the view.

Patient as I was, after about 15 minutes, my camera scanning the sun and reviewing the shot I would finally take, I grew frustrated. Was it too much to ask her to move so I could take just one picture of the scenery? Sure, I could have asked her, but something prevented me from doing so. Another 15 minutes passed and I grew bored. The woman was still there. I decided to take the photo anyway. And now when I look at it, I think her appearing in the photo is what makes the image interesting. The beautiful scenery on its own, somehow comes to life and breathes because this woman is engaging with it.

This photo, with the special beauty that unfolded before me and that woman who "ruined" it, now hangs on a wall in my bedroom.
