These days most Chinese choose to pay almost everything with our smartphones. But for foreign visitors, who aren't familiar with this way, it may seem different and strange.

Lim Swee Say, a man from Singapore was waiting in line to buy something to eat in a street in Shanghai and felt very strange to see other customers show their phones and take the food without giving over any cash. Soon after, he learned that these people were using WeChat Pay or Alipay. He was even more surprised to find that this kind of payment had reached almost every part of Chinese people's daily life now. Lim felt sorry that Singapore falls behind in mobile payments.

The popularity of mobile payments in China has made quite a few foreign companies use them in their countries. Now Chinese tourists can pay for things with their phones when they travel around because WeChat Pay has reached 13 countries and Alipay over 200. It's now common to see the well-known green or blue logos (标识) in places around the world, from a small restaurant in Thailand to a large shopping center in New York.

Although more and more countries start to use mobile payments, they aren't popular enough in other countries even in the USA. It was reported that Chinese mobile payments were nearly 50 times greater than those in the US last year.

This may be partly because Western mobile payment services want the businesses to buy expensive equipment(设备) before customers can use them. While in China, all it takes is a QR code and a smartphone.
