When is it time to retire? For many athletes, who spend their youth fighting for their dreams and honors, this is a difficult question.

Ning Zetao, China's world champion swimmer, decided to answer it on March 6, the day he turned 26 years old.

"I have no fear for either the past or the future. Today I want to say goodbye to the swimming pool and start a new chapter in my life... The way to success is never easy, push yourself and DO NOT SETTLE! To swimming, to youthfulness, " wrote Ning on his account on Sina Weibo.

In August, 2015, Ning made history by winning the men's 100m freestyle title at the FINA World Aquatics Championship in Kazan, Russia, becoming the first Asian swimmer to ever win a medal at the FINA world championship.

However, his career has been on the slide since. He failed to make the 100m final at the 2016 Rio Games. In December 2018, Ning attended the last event in his professional career in Australia where he won the men's 100m freestyle event. He did not compete in any following competition because of injury.

His family said he would go back to school. After all, every ending is a new beginning.

US writer Margaret Lee Runbeck once wrote, "Happiness is not a station you arrive at, but a manner of travelling." But travelling is not always happy, at least for the buddies in the movie **Green Book**. The popular film won Best Picture at the 91st Academy Awards on Feb 25.

The movie was adapted from the true story of a road trip through the southern US in the early 1960s. In the film, the black pianist Don Shirley hires Italian-American Tony Vallelonga to drive him to performances, but they face problems because of Shirley's skin color. These problems lead them to form a special friendship.

"There's something so deeply right about this movie, so true to the time," wrote US film critic Mick LaSalle. The time LaSalle is talking about was between late 1870s and 1960s, a very different period in US history. Many parts of the country had Jim Crow laws, which allowed racial segregation (种族隔离).

But in 1936, a black postman named Victor H. Green made a list of friendly businesses in New York City. He published the list as a small book with a green cover. **The Green Book** helped African-Americans travel more safely. Then, in 1964, Jim Crow laws went away. The book went away, too.

Shenzhen once again took part in Earth Hour, as a wide range of activities were held Saturday in Futian District to encourage people not only to switch off the lights between 8:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m., but also to join millions in protecting biodiversity in the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area.

Earth Hour, which is held annually, was started by World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF) in 2007. With this year's theme, "Connect to Earth", WWF also joined hands with One Planet Foundation (OPF) to invite experts to conduct research on and launch an ecological map of the Greater Bay Area, in order to call attention from all walks of life to the promotion of ecological progress in the area. The map was officially unveiled at the 2019 Earth Hour event at

SCPG Center in Futian.

In addition to this event, a carnival sharing the theme "Connect to Earth" was organized on Saturday and Sunday at the art square in Xiangmi Park, which was open to the public for free.

A representative from WWF and OPF said, "We hope this carnival, through various kinds of activities like games and handicrafts, will raise residents' awareness of the importance of biodiversity where we live. We want to engage more to protect valuable animals in the Greater Bay Area."

The two-day carnival attracted many children accompanied by their parents. A father on the scene told the **Shenzhen Daily**, "Interactions like this are great opportunities for kids to learn more about the earth, as they don't get to know this knowledge very often."

Besides Shenzhen, many other cities in China also held related activities with the same focus on biodiversity but based on the local ecological habitats.

Whenever we watch a horror movie and something scary happens, we might close our eyes and scream. However, chances are that we'll continue to watch and enjoy the movie anyway. So why can fear be so much fun?

According to a recent study conducted by researchers at the University of Pittsburgh in the US, watching horror movies can raise our mood, unite people and **boost** our confidence.

In the study, 262 adults were asked to enter a haunted house (鬼屋) attraction. In the haunted house for 35 minutes, they saw a series of tense scenes and were asked to record their feelings both before and after the experience. At the same time, the researchers also

monitored their brain waves.

According to the researchers, the participants were more likely to be happier and less anxious and tired after they left the attraction. That's because in this intense condition, their brains released more dopamine (多巴胺), a chemical which "produce a strong feeling of excitement and happiness lasting after the threat has passed," reported **Business Insider**.

What's more, taking advantage of this sensation may bring people together. People in scary situations are more likely to be uncertain and depend on others for support. "We're social and emotional beings—we need each other in times of stress, so we feel close to those we are with when afraid makes sense." Said Margee Kerr, one of the study's authors.

In addition, it could be a good way to boost our confidence. "Being scared in a safe place is a source of enjoyment and makes us feel good physically and can even serve as a confidence boost by reminding us that we can make it through a scary situation, we are strong," Kerr told **The Independent**.
