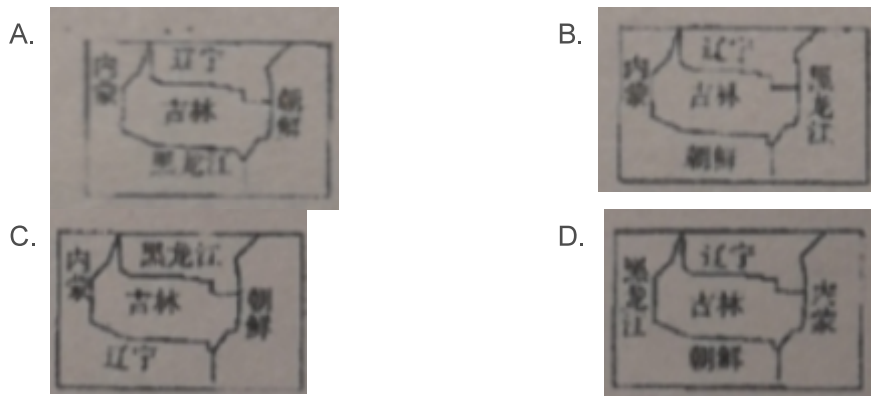

National parks are large areas of public land. They give a safe home for local plants and animals. They help keep the air and water clean. They also give us the best trips. Today, there are nearly 7, 000 national parks around the world. Forbes has listed 12 of the most beautiful ones in the world that will surprise you with their amazing landscapes, geographic wonders and colorful plants and animals.

The Grand Canyon ( 大峡谷 ) National Park of the US is one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World. It is best known for its size and depth. It is 446 kilometers long, up to 29 kilometers wide, and 1.6 kilometers deep. The immensity of the canyon makes people think big. Every year, about 5 million people visit here. Taking a tour in the South Rim offers visitors the park's full views, while the North Rim shows beautiful wild flowers.

If you love animals, you'll like the Serengeti National Park in Tanzania. The "Big Five" live here. They are the lion, African elephant, African leopard, black rhinoceros and African buffalo. The name "Big Five" came from the five animals that were the hardest to catch. Now they are what people most want to see in the wild. Phillip Island is a small island and nature reserve off the coast of South Australia, about 140 km from Melbourne. On the island you can see koalas, kangaroos and the main attraction, the Penguin Parade ( 企鹅归巢 ) on Summerland Beach.

As dusk was approaching, we made our way down to the beach, as did everyone else. On the beach was a stone grand stand, rather cold on the behind, so bring a coat or blanket to sit on. As it got darker, people talked less, keeping an eye out on the beach to see the arrival of that first penguin.

Suddenly there was movement at the edge of the surf and all heads turned as one. There, standing by the edge of the water was the smallest penguin we had ever seen. He looked left, then right, as if he was considering crossing a busy road and then he ran quickly across to the sand dunes and the penguin holes.

He must have been the scout ( 侦查员 ) , because after him, there came groups of penguins, some consisted of two or three penguins, and some had about ten or fifteen, but they all made the same mad dash across the sand into the holes, as if they couldn't get there fast enough. The groups started to lessen and finally no more penguins emerged from the sea.

We sat on the grand stand for a while, not talking, just feeling awed ( 敬畏的 ) at what we just seen. Neither of us had ever seen penguins in the wild before, only in zoos and it was an amazing feeling.

You could see the penguins here every evening and morning, but they weren't in cages or in small pools. The sea was their playground and it is a sight we would definitely recommend to anyone.

You weren't allowed to take flash photographs as it scared them. After the penguins had gone to their holes, you could walk along boardwalks and see them there. That's got to be

worth a look.

"Farm to table" is the name of a movement ( 运动 ) that encouraged people to eat locally grown food. In recent years, the farm-to-table idea has become more popular.

But there is also a group that brings "table to farm". This travelling group is called Outstanding in the Field. It says its mission ( 使命 ) is to bring people closer to where food comes from and walk around and get to know more about places like farms.

Jim Denevan is the founder of the group. He got the idea ten years ago. Recently, he prepared tables for more than a hundred people at Briars Farmstead in Virginia. He and his eight-member team arrived the night before. Cooks from a local restaurant prepared the dinner.

Matt Szechenyi and his family own Briars Farmstead. He said, "This type of movement connects us with a lot of enthusiastic ( 热心的 ) people whom we will form relationships with in the future."

The tour of the farm ended at the dinner table. The meats came from Matt Szechenyi's farm. The vegetables came from nearby farms. Guests and local farmers sat together.
