Tip 1: Starting the conversation with friendly greeting is the top thing. If you want to get a great answer, begin by saying "hello" first. And finish with a "thank you" and "have a nice day" .	Examples: Excuse me, could you help me? Hello! May I ask for some help? I need to get to the CN Tower.

16. China is a country with many colorful traditional festivals. The Dragon Head Raising Day is one of them.

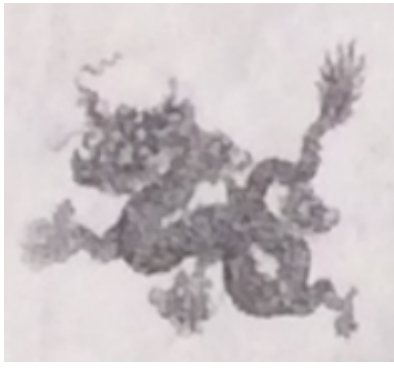


This special day is on the second day of the second month in the Chinese lunar calendar. It means the beginning of spring and farming.

The dragon is important in Chinese culture. We Chinese people call ourselves the "descendants (传人) of the dragon". So, it's traditional for many people to celebrate this festival.

There is an old saying. If the dragon doesn't raise its head, it won't rain. The dragon is the god who is in charge of (掌管) the rain. How much it rains decides whether the farmers could have a big and successful harvest (收成). It shows our humans want to get along well with the nature. That's why we celebrate this festival.

In ancient times, people put ashes (灰) in the kitchen. They believed this could help "lead the dragon into the house". People believed that with the help of the dragon, their fruits and vegetables could grow well.



Also, people eat special food on that day. The names of the food have some relationships with the word "dragon" . For example, people eat "dragon whisker" noodles (龙须面) and dumplings called "dragon ears" .

Today, many traditions have disappeared. But cutting hair is still an important tradition in many places. It's called "cutting the dragon head." This shows the good beginning of the year. It brings good luck. Many old people believe that haircut during the first lunar month may bring bad luck to their relatives. So many people choose to cut their hair on the Dragon Head Raising

Day though it costs more.

25. Environmental-friendly rain gardens have beautiful flowers, trees and other plants that beautify the neighborhood. They are also healthy for the environment and the people living and working nearby. A rain garden is not very different from a traditional garden. It is just far more environmental-friendly. Usually we build it lower than the ground.



Why Environmental-friendly Rain Gardens Are Suggested

Rain gardens smartly used rain and storm water by holding water from rain for a short time and storms and letting it get into the ground slowly before it runs into small rivers or enters the public drinking water supply (供给) . In this way, a rain garden keeps the water, allowing it to be used as needed by plants in the rain garden, rather than running directly into nearby rivers and going unused.

The water will be taken slowly into the ground within a day or two. This creates a great influence that the rain garden does not allow mosquitoes (蚊子) to breed (繁殖) . This is a simple, attractive, and environmental-friendly "green" way to treat storm water.

What's more, planting a rain garden helps cut down on pollution and make the environment better. The gardens don't use expensive machinery and chemical materials. They remove harmful chemical materials in the rainwater and cut down the amount (量) of pollution recalling rivers by up to 30%.

How You Build Your Own Rain Gardens

Local plants are suggested for rain gardens because they are more used to the local weather, soil, and water conditions. They may attract local wildlife such as native birds. Water your rain garden right after planting and once a week. Don't water it if you have had at least an inch (英寸) of rain during the week. You don't have to take much care of it when the plants have necessary root system (根系统) .

Often, local governments and private businesses develop large rain gardens in their yards and in public parks. However, you can do your own part. It's not necessary for you to be an environmental engineer to create a rain garden. Just start by building smaller rain gardens in your yards.
