第一部分 试卷总评

本次武珞路的试卷难度中等,综合考察学生能力。单选部分题目有一定难度,考察的知识点多为词汇,学生需要多了解词汇用法,易错题为 32/36/37/39/40。完形为故事类型的文章。难度中等偏上,易错题为 47/51/52。阅读理解较难,A 篇考察细节,B 篇比较考察学生的理解能力,较难,C 篇为故事类的文章,难度一般。整个阅读理解的易错题为 63/65。完成句子和用所给词填空考察课本基础知识点,易错题为 74/77。这次的首字母填词相对简单,考察上下文理解比较多,做题时需要注意动词形式,易错题为 86/90。

一、单选易错题

## 二、完形填空易错题

47.【解析】答案为 C 项。**本题考查动词辨析**。serve 作为“端上”的意思，符合题意。

51.【解析】答案为 D 项。**本题考查代词辨析**。这里要结合语境才能够推出正确答案。上文我妈妈提到，你可以为了钱吃豆子，那也可以为了爱吃。听到这句话作者感到绝望，他知道这是没有理由拒绝的，因此他意识到他把他自己置身在了每一个无路可退的境地。每一个，everything.

52.【解析】答案为 D 项。**本题考查介词辨析**。根据前文可知，作者是没有理由反对拒绝的，因此选 against，表示反对。

## 四、阅读理解易错题

63.【解析】答案为 C 项。**本题为推断题**。定位到文章最后一段，意为“不管发生了什么，我知道你都会在我身边”。最后一段和文章第三段第二行的句子相呼应，因此可以推断出来这位父亲没有违背诺言。

65.【解析】答案为 A 项。**本题为猜词题**。Debris 定位在文章第三段第二行的末尾。当地震发生了，学校的教学楼都被摧毁成了一堆瓦砾，也就是破碎的砖头瓦片。这个词通常和 a pile of 连用。
