## B

On the field he's the graceful, creative, and skillful star of both Brazil national team and one of the soccer's wealthiest, most ambitious clubs. In early August, the 25-year-old moved from Spain's FC Barcelona to France's Paris Saint-Germain in the most expensive soccer deal(交易) ever. He's known simply as Neymar, and he brings fans all over the world to their feet.

But sitting at the piano, he's Neymar da Silva Junior. That's his full name, and during a June photo shoot inside a crowded studio, it took him several minutes to gather the nerve(聚精会神) to try a couple of songs, including the theme(主题) from the classic track-and-field film Chariots of Fire.

Neymar left Brazil for Barcelona in 2013 and says, "There was a piano in the house when I moved in." It was fate(注定的). He enjoys being around musicians—there's a video of him playing soccer with Justin Bieber—and he's even been known to climb on stage during concerts back home.

"I like to get to know people I admire," he says. Some of them are athletes(运动员), and some of them are singers."

Maybe someday he'll be able to play along. Neymar has been using YouTube clips to teach himself piano, and he enjoys a variety of music—from Brazilian country music to Bieber and John Legend. It's a valuable diversion for someone who's under a spotlight.

"Sometimes I'm a little active—sometimes I'm quiet. I like to have fun," he says. "We have only one life, so we have to figure out a way to be happy."

 This is why I wanted my girls to be a part of my grandpa's passing. I wanted them to see everyone in our family supporting each other, offering love to each other.  
 I asked them if they wanted to come with me. My girls' voices didn't waver for a second. "Yes." And so we went. We filled his house with as much love as we could. Ula played with toys at his feet while Sarah petted her cats.  
 Suddenly, Ula waved her arms to get my attention. "Mommy! I have to whisper you a secret." I knelt down in front of her. "Please don't tell Great Grandpa this, but I don't like watching him die." I hugged her. Not knowing what else to say, I whispered back, "It's OK to feel that way."

#### 第一部分 试卷总评

本次洪山区的期中考试,总体难度较大,注重综合能力的考查。单选题较为灵活多变,均是中考核心词汇,语法也和中考的必考语法点一致,易错题为 31/33/38 题。完形难度中等偏上,故事简单易懂,但是有某些词汇辨析表达非常灵活具体,需要在语境中多加注意,比如 47/49/55 题;阅读本次难度正常,但需要大家熟练掌握和运用做题技巧。其他细节题和推理判断基本不纠结,只要大家认真在原文划证据找依据,基本问题不大。阅读易错题为 59/62/68 题。首填难度正常,很考察大家对于词语搭配和一词多义掌握情况,也是拉分的板块,易错题为 76/83/85。

#### 第二部分 易错题解析

##### 一. 单选易错题

31. 【解析】答案为 B 项, 本题考察宾语从句语序。当特殊疑问词在从句中不充当主语是, 宾语从句语序为陈述句语序, B 选项符合此要求, 答语的意思是我想知道他是否可以自己完成。故选 B。

33. 【解析】答案为 A 项, 本题考察动词辨析。题干的意思是这所学校因为教学杰出而得到广泛的赞许。A 选项 admire 意思是称赞; 欣赏, 羡慕。B 选项 request 意思是下级对上级的) 请求; 请求得到。C 选项 require 意思是要求; 命令。D 选项 mention 意思是提及。故选择 A。

38. 【解析】答案为 D 项, 本题考察副词辨析。题干意思是我通常是从不给杂志写信的, 但斯塔布斯先生最后太出格了。A 选项 exactly 意思是恰好地; 正是。B 选项 daily 意思是日常。C 选项 widely 广泛地。D 选项 normally 意思是通常故选 D。

##### 二. 完形填空易错题

47. 【解析】答案为 B 项。本题考察名词辨析。上文提及了 When we arrived back home, 那么

下文的意思应该是当我的父母忙于家务时，我冲向了车库去找盒子。只有 B.chores 家务符合文意；故选择 B。

49.【解析】答案为 D 项。本题考查名词辨析。上文说作者急切地找盒子是想看到盒子里他最喜爱的弹簧高跷仗，但是不走运的是盒子里却只有一把扫帚，“No such luck”意思是不走运，故选 A。

55.【解析】答案为 A 项。本题考查名词辨析。上文提到虽然作者家里不是很富裕，但是作者的父母还是给他买了最想要的生日礼物，让作者感受到父母对他满满的爱，所以这里的意思是“我绝不会忘记父母给我人生中带来的快乐”，只有 A. joy 欢乐 符合文意，故选 B

#### 四、阅读理解易错题

##### A 篇

59.【解析】答案为 A 项，本题是细节题。



##### B 篇

62.【解析】答案为 B 项，本题是细节题。根据第一段信息：在八月上旬，这位 25 岁的小伙子从西班牙巴塞罗那俱乐部转到了法国巴黎圣日耳曼足球俱乐部，这是足球史上最贵的一场交易。故不是搬家，而是转会，选 B。

##### C 篇：

68.【解析】答案为 B 项，本题是推断题。根据上下文，作者回忆小时候面对亲戚因癌症去世的故事，发现我并没有来得及跟她说再见，在葬礼上也觉得自己不属于那里，感觉失去了些很多。故选 B。

#### 五、阅读理解填词易错题

76. 答案为 holiday。易错点是被 Easter 误导往 historical 想，但这里要注意句子结构的分析，该句缺的是名词，再结合 celebrated，得知该填 holiday。

83. 答案为 conversation。这里同样要注意句子结构的分析，该句缺的是名词。

85. 答案为 breaking。这里容易填成 broken，但通过分析句子结构，发现“my car's breaking down”是主语(名词短语)。
