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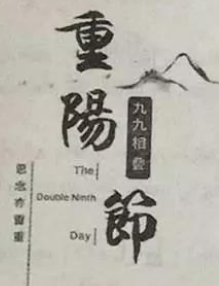

The Double Ninth Festival, a traditional Chinese festival, falls on the ninth day of the ninth lunar month. The festival began to be celebrated as early as in the Warring States Period (战国时期) and became a national folk festival during the Tang Dynasty. On that day, people, especially old people, usually climb a high mountain. They think it can prevent disasters and bring good luck. Many other different kinds of activities are held to help old people exchange feelings with each other. In some families people come together to remember their ancestors, appreciating chrysanthemums (菊花) and drinking chrysanthemum wine. Because "double ninth" sounds like "forever" in Chinese, people relate the Double Ninth Festival to the

good wish of longevity (长寿) to the old.

In 1989, the Double Ninth Festival was officially decided as the Seniors' Day to show our respect and love to the elder people. This festival, therefore, continues to play a role in carrying on culture in the new era.

Respecting the elderly is one of the traditional virtues (美德) of the Chinese nation. China's law says that grown-up children should to support their parents. If they don't live with their parents, they should give their parents the living allowances and help them with the house work. However, because of the development of society and the pressure from life, now more and more young people fail to go home often to visit their parents. In July, 2013, "regularly visit aging parents" was put into the law.

**第一部分 试卷总评**

本次江汉区的期中考试,总体难度中等,注重综合能力的考查。单选题会比较纠结,均是课本的核心词汇,语法也和中考的必考语法点一致,易错题为 30/33/38 题。完形难度中等偏上,故事简单易懂,但是有某些词汇辨析需要注意,比如 46/49/54 题;阅读本次难度不大,多数考查细节题,认真在原文画出,并且比对选项不难选出正确答案。猜词题和最佳标题难度中等。阅读易错题为 56/65/70 题。选词送分题,也是所有的孩子必须拿满分的题型;首填难度较大,考查一词多义掌握情况,注意变形,易错题为 80/81/83。

**第二部分 易错题解析**

**一、单选易错题**

30.【解析】答案为 A 项, 本题考查名词辨析。本题首先可根据题意排除 D 选项, 酒驾是交通事故很常见的一种起因。cause 表示造成某一事实或现象的直接原因或起因(后常接 of); reason 常用于说明或解释某种行为或看法的理由(后接 for 或不定式); excuse 常指借口、辩解(后常接 of)。故选 A。

33.【解析】答案为 A 项, 本题考查时态。注意此题答语里的“is”是陷阱, 要注意问句里的“yesterday”, 问句中的宾是从对昨天发生的事提问。故选 A。

38.【解析】答案为 C 项, 本题考查短语辨析。句意: 汽车排放出大量的烟和污染物, 这就导致北京糟糕的空气。give away 意为赠送; 泄露; 失去。give up 意为放弃; 投降; 把...让给; 戒除; give off



意为发出；放出；散发出；放射出；give in 意为让步；屈服；交；投降。故选 C。

## 二、完形填空易错题

46.【解析】答案为 A 项。本题考查上下文推理。上文提到当两个乞丐发现一个富有的男人走向他们，他们的内心是很激动且充满着期待的，可知两个乞丐尽量不直勾勾地看着那个男人，所以选 A。

49.【解析】答案为 A 项。本题考查形容词辨析。句意那个富有的男人本可以留下一些硬币或备用的账单。Spare 意为多余的，备用的；separate 意为分离的；private 意为隐私的；rich 意为富有的。故选 A。

54.【解析】答案为 D 项。本题考查上下文。根据上下文，钻石是被糖纸包着的，乞丐打开糖纸惊讶地发现钻石，picked 捡起，got 拿到，mailed 邮寄，unfolded 展开，打开。故选 D。

## 四、阅读理解易错题

### A 篇

56.【解析】答案为 C 项，本题是文章选材题，最上面 summer camp 知道是夏令营活动，排除 BD，然后 A 选项 job fair 是招聘会的意思，不符合，从下面知道是提供给孩子们的一些活动，可以选 C 表示有教育意义的俱乐部。

### B 篇

65.【解析】答案为 B 项，本题是猜词题，通过上半句：如果他们不和父母住在一起，他们应该给他们的父母生活\_\_\_\_\_，并且帮助他们做家务。这里推出应该是给父母一些钱去赡养，本段第二行也提到说成年人应该赡养父母，所以选 B，这里 living allowances 是生活津贴，补贴的意思

### C 篇：

70.【解析】答案为 A 项，本题是最佳标题。由文章第一段 My mom isn't fancy 到徒步旅行，妈妈非常勇敢，再到 Everyone joins, even the fancy mom 可知，文章从描写妈妈穿着打扮不够精致，然后抓蛇这一勇敢行动，最后为妈妈的不精致感到骄傲，一直都是围绕 My mom isn't fancy 来写的，所以选 A。D 选项只是妈妈不精致的的一个表现，并不是文章想着重告诉我们的。
