This year saw smart people always busy inventing useful things, which have helped to make the world better, smarter and a little more fun. Now, let's take a look at some of the inventions.

Super banana

Australian scientist James Dale visited Uganda, a poor African country, in the early 2000s, where he found that 15% - 30% of children under 5 were at the risk of going blind because they didn't get enough vitamin A.

Dale also learned that people there love bananas. They eat 3 to 11 bananas a day. So he came up with an idea to plant bananas having added nutrition(营养)in order to improve Ugandans' health. With the help of Bill Gates, Dale developed the "super banana". He added a gene to the fruit, making it rich in vitamin A.

The hovercraft

Thanks to the product Hendo, flying past your friends on a floating(漂浮)board could soon become a reality. The hovercraft has 4 small engines. These create a special magnetic field which produces enough force to lift the board off the ground.

At the moment, the board can only float an inch off the ground for 15 minutes and must fly over a metal material. It's expensive too, but the company hopes that one day the technology could be used.

Coaching basketball

Basketball is popular worldwide, partly because you only need a hoop and a ball to play the game. But this simple game experienced a technology change with the development of a smart sensor (传感器) basketball.

The ball, called the 94 Fifty Basketball, has 9 sensors inside." They can tell you anything from how fast you are going to how good your shot angles(角) are.

With a Bluetooth chip inside, the basketball can connect to your smartphone and tell you in the voice of a coach to "throw the ball quickly" or "go faster"...

Wireless electricity

Most of us could not stand living WiTricity without wireless Internet. We use it every day for everything from our phones to our cars. But one company wants to go a step further by getting wireless technology with electricity.

That's right, no more wires and no more having to sit and hold your cellphone near a power socket(插座) in the corner of the room. WiTricity, a US company, has invented technology that can power objects up to 2.4 meters away. It uses a special plug-in coil(线圈) that creates a magnetic field!

第一部分 试卷总评

本次武珞路的期中考试,总体难度适中,注重综合能力的考查。单选题较为稍难,均是课本的核心词汇,但考察用法偏难,语法和中考的必考语法点一致,易错题为 27/34/35/40 题。完形难度适中,故事易懂,但是有某些词汇辨析和文中含义要注意,比如 42/47/54 题;阅读在推断题部分较容易出错,需要大家运用做题技巧,易错题为 56/58/62/69 题。选词送分题,也是所有的孩子必须拿满分的题型;首填难度是所有题型中的最大,也是拉分的板块,易错 76/83/85 题。

第二部分 易错题解析

一、单选易错题

27.【解析】答案为 A 项, 本题考形容词辨析。A 项“缺席的”, B 项“出席的, 现在的”, C 项“直的, 坦率的”, D 项“直接的”, absent look 固定说法, 表示“魂不守舍的样子”。故选 A。

34.【解析】答案为 B 项, 本题考查固定句式。When/If it comes to the point... 表示“必须作决定时...”。故选 B。

35.【解析】答案为 A 项, 本题考查动词辨析。A 项原形 bear “忍受, 承担, 结果实, 生育”, B 项原形 wear “穿”, C 项原形 process “加工, 处理”, D 项原形 make “制作”, bear fruit 有成果, 成功。故选 A。

40.【解析】答案为 C 项, 本题考查宾语从句。根据语序先排除 B 项, 再根据回答“我猜是为了去准备语文考试”, 所以只有 C 项句意符合“他为什么这么早离开”。故选 C。

二、完形填空易错题

42.【解析】答案为 B 项。本题考短语辨析。A 项“答复”，B 项“同意”，C 项“与...争吵”，D 项“聆听”，根据文意应为“我最亲密的朋友 Jake 也同意我的观点：女孩子不应该总是被那样对待”，所以选 B。

47.【解析】答案为 D 项。本题考查动词辨析。A 项“钦佩”，B 项“喊叫”，C 项“指着”，D 项“轻声说”，根据上下文，我们去偷女生的芭比娃娃，所以“我”在给 Jake 指令的时候应该是小声说的，故选 D。

54.【解析】答案为 D 项。本题考查动词辨析。此题容易误选为 B 项 spread “传播”，根据上下文，只有 Jake 至今还因为裙子的事笑我，所以关于我裙子的话题已经在男孩间消失了，故选 C。

四、阅读理解易错题

A 篇

56.【解析】答案为 B 项，本题是体裁判断题。根据图片“关于怎么使用，怎么储存”等内容可知，图片为“说明书，使用指南”即 instructions，故选 B。

58.【解析】答案为 C 项，本题是细节题。在图片最左边有一行字“EXP 06 2020”，EXP 表示“失效日期”，所以选 C。

B 篇

62.【解析】答案为 D 项，本题是推理题。根据前文：Dale 利用人们爱吃香蕉这一习惯，使用生物技术让香蕉富含维生素 A，从而来改善人们的健康。故 D 项“人们的饮食习惯可以用来发展新食品”符合题意。容易错选 C，但是文章并没有提到“超级香蕉”是绝对安全的生物产品，推理题必须遵照原文中心思想，故本题选择 D 项。

C 篇

69.【解析】答案为 D 项，本题是推理题。文章首句“Raised in a motherless home...” , 这个地方的 motherless 有两层含义，第一层为母亲已经去世，第二层为母亲不住在身边，所以不能按照 D 选项武断说作者没有母亲，故选 D。

五、阅读理解填词易错题

76. 答案为 part。海洋上的塑料污染每年会杀死很多海洋哺乳类动物，而吸管只是塑料的一类，即也是造成哺乳类动物死亡的一部分原因。

83. 答案为 increasing。首句中 even though 引起的条件句，提到虽然纤维吸管比塑料吸管要贵五倍多，但是产量仍在上升。主要结合上下文提到纤维吸管的优点以及台湾，加尼福尼亚等都会放弃塑料吸管的生产可知，生产纤维吸管大势所趋。

85. 答案为 also。这里考查上下文推理，台湾，加尼福尼亚都会放弃塑料吸管的生产，Starbucks 星巴克也会放弃生产，phase out 指的是“使逐步淘汰”。
