What to do

- ※Put the cream, strawberries, sugar, and vanilla in the smaller quarter-size plastic bag.
- ※Fill the larger gallon-size bag halfway with rice. Add the salt and ice cube (冰块).
- ※Put the smaller bag (with the mixture) inside the larger bag with the rice, salt and ice cube. Close the bag tightly (紧密的).
- ※Shake the bags for five minutes. Wear gloves so your hands don't feel cold.
- ※When ready, remove the small bag from the larger one. Wash off the salt with cold water. Now, open up the bag and enjoy your ice cream.
