



jewellery ['dʒu:əlri] n.

释义：decorative objects worn on your clothes or body that are usually made from valuable metals, such as gold and silver, and precious stones.

珠宝

拓展：jewelry n. (美) 珠宝

例句：Kelly's **jewellery** was stolen.
凯莉的珠宝被偷了。



jumper [ˈdʒʌmpə(r)] n.

释义：a piece of clothing with long sleeves that is usually made from wool, is worn on the upper part of the body and does not open at the front.

短衫，套头衫

拓展：put on a jumper 穿上套头衫

例句：It's very cold so put a **jumper** on.
天气冷，把套头衫穿上吧。



lipstick [ˈlɪpstɪk] n.

释义：a coloured substance that women put on their lips to make them more attractive.

唇膏

拓展：wear lipstick 涂口红

例句：Students are not allowed to wear **lipstick** at school.
学生们在校期间不许擦口红。





perfume

[ˈpɜːfjuːm] n.

释义：a liquid with a pleasant smell, usually made from oils taken from flowers or spices and often used on the skin. 香水

拓展：wear perfume 喷香水

例句：What **perfume** are you wearing?
你用的是什么香水？



pocket

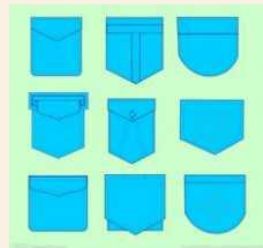
[ˈpɒkɪt] n.

释义：a container, usually made of cloth, that is sewn into or onto a bag or attached to a seat or door in a vehicle.

口袋；袋子

拓展：a coat pocket 外衣口袋

例句：He took some coins out of his coat **pocket**.
他从口袋里掏出几枚硬币。





pullover

[ˈpʊləʊvə(r)] n.

释义：a piece of clothing that is usually made of a warm material such as wool, has long sleeves, and is worn over the top part of the body and is put on by pulling it over your head. 套衫

拓展：jumper n.套头衫

例句：This woollen **pullover** fits you well.

这件羊毛套衫你穿很合身。



sleeve

[sli:v] n.

释义：the part of a piece of clothing that covers some or all of the arm. 袖子

拓展：roll up the sleeves 卷起袖子

例句：You'd better roll your **sleeves** up or you'll get them dirty.

你最好卷起袖子，否则会把它们弄脏的。





spot [spot] n.&v.

释义：a small, usually round area of colour that is differently coloured or lighter or darker than the surface around it.

污点；现场；发现

拓展：on the spot 在现场

例句：He had a **spot** of grease on his tie.

他的领带上有一小块油渍。



sweatshirt ['swetʃɜ:t] n.

释义：a piece of informal clothing with long sleeves, worn on the upper part of the body.

圆领长袖运动衫

拓展：sweatpants n. 运动裤

例句：She was dressed casually in jeans and a **sweatshirt**.

她很随意地穿着一条牛仔裤和一件运动衫。





tracksuit

[ˈtræksu:t] n.

释义：a loose top and trousers, worn either by people who are training for a sport or exercising, or as informal clothing. 运动套装

拓展：tracksuit bottom 运动裤

例句：I changed into a **tracksuit**.
我换上一身运动装。



knitted

[ˈnɪtɪd] adj.

释义：made using wool or thick cotton and two long needles. 编织的

拓展：hand-knitted adj. 手工编织的

例句：Last birthday, I received a
hand-**knitted** scarf from Abby.
去年生日，艾比送我一条手工织的围巾。



leather [ˈleðə(r)] n.

释义 : animal skin treated in order to preserve it, and used to make shoes, bags, clothes, equipment, etc.

皮革

拓展 : a leather coat 皮衣

例句 : Have you seen Mike' s new **leather** jacket?

你见过麦克的新皮夹克了吗？



loose [lu:s] adj.

释义 : not firmly held or fastened in place.

松动的；宽松的

拓展 : come loose 松掉，变松

例句 : The nails in the wall had come **loose**.

墙上的钉子已经松动了。





woollen

[ˈwʊlɪn] adj.

释义：made of wool. 羊毛的

拓展：woolen adj. (美) 羊毛的



例句：Jenny wears a **woollen** scarf today.
珍妮今天围了一条羊毛围巾。



fit

[fɪt] v.

释义：to be the right size or shape for someone or something. 适合

拓展：fit sb. 合身

例句：That jacket **fits** you perfectly.
那件夹克你穿着很合身。
